ORDER GRANTING FULL LICENSURE

An informal settlement conference was conducted in the above-captioned matter before the Veterinary Examining Board on June 17, 1998. The board thereafter presented a proposed Stipulation for Dr. Rechsteiner's consideration, which was ultimately executed by Dr. Rechsteiner and the board. By the terms of the board's Order adopting the Stipulation, Dr. Rechsteiner's license was limited to require that within nine months of the date of the Order, Dr. Rechsteiner complete an educational program preapproved by the board consisting of at least 20 hours in the diagnosis and the medical and surgical management of gastrointestinal disorders in small animals, including cats, and an educational program preapproved by the board consisting of at least five hours in wound management.

On December 9, 1998, the board considered evidence of Dr. Rechsteiner's completion of the required programs. Based on that evidence, the board orders as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that all limitations on the license of Neil Rechsteiner, D.V.M., to practice veterinary medicine in the State of Wisconsin are terminated, and Dr. Rechsteiner is hereby returned to full licensure.
