ORDER GRANTING FULL LICENSURE

---

On June 17, 1998, the Veterinary Examining Board issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, respondent's license was limited to require that within six months she complete a course on the diagnosis and treatment of emergency disorders to be conducted through the University of Wisconsin School of Veterinary Medicine.

On June 30, 1999, the board considered Dr. Johnson's petition for return to full licensure. Based upon the entire record in this matter, including documentation of respondent's full compliance with the terms and conditions of her limited license, the board orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that all limitations on the license of Carey E. Johnson, D.V.M., to practice veterinary medicine in the State of Wisconsin, as imposed by the board's Final Decision and Order in this matter dated June 17, 1998, be, and hereby are, terminated, and Dr. Johnson is hereby returned to full licensure.
