An informal settlement conference was conducted in the above-captioned matter before the Veterinary Examining Board on May 24, 2000. The purpose of the conference was to provide interested parties with an opportunity to discuss allegations received pertaining to the practice of Dr. SanFilippo as a veterinarian, and to attempt to reach a fair and consensual resolution of the matter.

Dr. SanFilippo appeared in person and without legal counsel. Others present in addition to the board included Pamela M. Stach, attorney for the Department of Regulation & Licensing, Division of Enforcement, and Wayne Austin, the board's legal counsel.

The parties orally presented their respective positions regarding the matter to the board, and the board deliberated on a possible disposition of the matter. The board thereafter presented a proposed Stipulation for Dr. SanFilippo's consideration, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof. The Stipulation was ultimately executed by Dr. SanFilippo, Ms. Stach and Dr. Diane Scott, board chair.

Based upon the proceedings at the conference, and upon the Stipulation of the parties, the board enters the following order.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Dr. SanFilippo shall, within nine months of the date of this Order, complete at least eight hours of continuing education approved in advance by the board in the area of record-keeping.
