The parties in this matter, Shahid H. Chughtai, D.V.M., Respondent, his attorney, Paul Literski, and Pamela M. Stach, attorney for the Department of Regulation and Licensing, agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Wisconsin Veterinary Examining Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. That Shahid H. Chughtai, D.V.M., Respondent herein, of 7123 S. 76th St., Franklin, WI 53132, whose date of birth is 12/1/1958, is licensed and currently registered to practice veterinary medicine in the State of Wisconsin under license # 3799 which was granted on 4/22/1992.

2. A formal investigation, entitled 00 VET 014, is pending before the Wisconsin Veterinary Examining Board.

3. The Veterinary Examining Board has previously disciplined the Respondent.

4. On 3/6/2000, "Tabatha" a nine-week-old male cat was taken to the American Veterinary Clinic because of a two-day history of loose, bloody stools. The respondent made a diagnosis of roundworms and treated Tabatha with Albon and he recommended giving A/D canned food to "Tabatha" for two to three days. A prophylactic

vaccination of dist-rhino-calici-chlamydia # 1 was administered.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Veterinary Examining Board has jurisdiction in this proceeding pursuant to Wis. Stats. Sec. 453.04.
2. The Wisconsin Veterinary Examining Board has the authority to resolve this proceeding by Stipulation without an evidentiary hearing pursuant to Wis. Stats. Sec. 227.44(5).
3. Respondent's conduct of administering a prophylactic vaccination to an animal while it was ill constituted a violation of Wis. Admin. Code sec. VE 7.06(1).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Stipulation of the parties is approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that Shahid H. Chughtai, D.V.M., is REPRIMANDED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Shahid H. Chughtai, D.V.M., shall pay COSTS in the amount of THREE HUNDRED dollars (\$300.00). Payment shall be submitted within sixty (60) days from the date of this order. Payment shall be made by certified check or money order, payable to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing and sent to: Department Monitor, Division of Enforcement, Dept. of Regulation & Licensing, P. O. Box 8935, Madison, WI 53708-8935

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the pending investigation 00 VET 014 is closed without further proceedings.

The rights of a party aggrieved by this Final Decision And Order to petition the Wisconsin Veterinary Examining Board for rehearing and to petition for judicial review are set forth in the attached "Notice of Appeal Information".
