The Veterinary Examining Board entered its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter on March 12, 2003. By the terms of the board's Order, Ms. Rhode's license was limited to require that within six months from the date of the order, she submit documentation of successful completion of at least ten hours of continuing education, therapy or other training acceptable to the Board in the areas of anger and/or stress management. Also, within 12 months from the date of the order, Ms. Rhode was required to submit documentation of successful completion of at least six hours of continuing education or other training acceptable to the Board in the area of restraint and management of animals. Finally, for a period of six months from the date of the Order, Ms. Rhode was required to arrange for quarterly reports from her veterinary employer(s) reporting the terms and conditions of her employment and evaluating her work performance.

On November 12, 2003, the board considered Ms. Rhode's request for termination of the limitations on her license. Based upon all information of record herein, the board orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that all limitations on the license of Terri A. Rhode to practice as a veterinary technician in Wisconsin are terminated, and Ms. Rhode is hereby reinstated to full licensure.
