The Veterinary Examining Board considered this matter at its meeting on August 8, 2007.

BACKGROUND

On May 11, 2007, the Veterinary Examining Board denied Dr. Niedermeier's request for reinstatement of her license based upon the fact that she practiced veterinary medicine after the expiration of her license, and the Board's conclusion that she did not provide sufficient assurance of competency to practice as a veterinarian. The Board decided to grant Dr. Niedermeier a limited license to practice veterinary medicine; provided that she passes the small animal portion of the Veterinary Clinical Skills Assessment test.

In June, 2007, DR. Niedermeier passed the small animal portion of the Veterinary Clinical Skills Assessment test. She was granted a limited license on June 27, 2007. Dr. Niedermeier's license was limited in that she was required to attend the first meeting of the Wisconsin Veterinary Examining Board following issuance of the limited license, and to submit proof of a current, valid, unrestricted DEA registration.

On August 8, 2007, Dr. Niedermeier appeared before the Veterinary Examining Board and submitted proof of a current, valid, unrestricted DEA registration. Based upon all the information of record, the Board orders the following:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the limitation placed on the license (#1316-50) of Janice Niedermeier, D.V.M., to practice veterinary medicine in the state of Wisconsin be, and hereby is, removed and that her license be returned to full unlimited status.

This order is effective on the date it is signed by a designee of the Board.
