ORDER OF SUSPENSION

On October 24, 2007, the Veterinary Examining Board issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, respondent's license to practice as a veterinary in Wisconsin was limited, conditioned upon respondent's compliance with specified terms and conditions. Included among these was that respondent participate in an approved drug program which included daily call-ins and random drug screening, submit quarterly therapy and work reports.

On November 19, 2007, the board considered evidence that Dr. Halama Larson has not been in compliance with the limitations on her license by consuming and testing positive for alcohol on November 1, 2007.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the license of Beverly Halama Larson, D.V.M., (50-3267) is hereby suspended. Respondent must show three months full compliance with all the terms and conditions of the Final Decision & Order prior to re-petitioning for a stay of suspension. This order is effective immediately.
