PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Veterinary Examining Board. The Board has reviewed the attached Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Robert H. Steiner, D.V.M., (DOB 07/11/1962) is duly licensed to practice veterinary medicine in the state of Wisconsin (license #50-4016). This license was first granted on May 17, 1993.
2. Dr. Steiner's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Veterinary Examining Board is N1742 Adlaw Drive, Lodi, WI 53555.
3. At all times relevant to this action, Dr. Steiner was working as a veterinarian for Lodi Veterinary Clinic, 705 N. Main Street, Lodi, Wisconsin.
4. Dr. Steiner practiced with an expired Wisconsin veterinary medicine license (#50-4016) from approximately January 1, 2006 and continuing on to January 23, 2007, when the license was renewed. Dr. Steiner's failure to renew in a timely manner was inadvertent.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Veterinary Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 453.04 and Wis. Stat. § 453.07 and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation and Order, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44 (5).

2. The conduct described in paragraph 4, above, constitutes a violation of Wisconsin Administrative Code § VE 7.06 (20).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the stipulation of the parties, as attached hereto, is accepted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Robert H. Steiner, D.V.M. is hereby REPRIMANDED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Robert H. Steiner, D.V.M. shall pay costs in the amount of ONE HUNDRED dollars (\$100.00). Payment shall be submitted within sixty (60) days from the date of this order. Violation of any of the terms of this Order may be construed as conduct imperiling public health, safety and welfare and may result in a summary suspension of Respondent's license. The Board in its discretion may in the alternative impose additional conditions and limitations or other additional discipline for a violation of any of the terms of this Order. In the event the Respondent fails to pay costs as ordered the Respondent's license SHALL BE SUSPENDED until the Respondent has complied with the terms of this Order.
